



## **RV RIVER KWAI 4-DAY/3-NIGHT GOLF DOWNSTREAM CRUISE**

The RV River Kwai, the first inland cruise ship in Thailand, is a newly built colonial style river cruiser based on designs used by the original Irrawaddy Flotilla which was founded in Burma in 1865 and by the 1920s was the largest privately owned fleet of ships in the world.

The RV River Kwai carries a maximum of 20 passengers in 10 teakwood cabins (single deck) and operates on a 4 days/3 nights year round program every Monday-Thursday and Thursday-Sunday on both Upstream and Downstream programs alternately.

The RV River Kwai opens up an entirely new area for river tourism in Kanchanaburi province west of Bangkok. Every morning and afternoon land excursions are offered to visit attractions along the river including temples, historic sites, Khmer ruins, waterfalls, war cemeteries, hot springs, the bridge on the River Kwai, and local attractions, etc.

The RV River Kwai is also available for special Golf Charter Cruises on request.

### **Itinerary: Program II - Downstream**

#### **THURSDAY**

##### **DAY 1 BANGKOK-KANCHANABURI-THONG PHA PHUM-BAN HIN DAD [-/L/D]**

**06:00** Depart from Bangkok by van/coach to Kanchanaburi via Nakhon Pathom.

**08:30** First day's golf is at the **Mission Hills Golf Club Kanchanaburi**, one of the most beautiful courses in western Thailand. The fairways are lined with thousands of mature palms, the course itself winds round gently sloping hills and the clubhouse, clad in timber, make this a truly sensation golfing experience, and a great way to finish a tour of this fascinating region of the country.

**14:00** Lunch at Sommai Restaurant.

**15:00** Continue to Thong Pha Phum. If time allows, visit to Vachiralongkorn Dam, an immense lake created from the waters of three rivers harnessed by the hydroelectric dam which stretches to the far horizon. The thick jungle through which the railway line cut a swathe in recent times has been tamed and the surrounding fertile land now supports agricultural crops - sugar cane, tapioca, tobacco, maize and cotton. The admirable rugged scenery of the lake set against rolling hills on the distant horizon is ample reward for the long journey.

**16:00** Embark on RV River Kwai and cruise along Kwai Noi River.

**19:30** Dinner and overnight on board.

#### **FRIDAY**

##### **DAY 2 BAN HIN DAD-SAI YOK YAI-SAI YOK [B/L/D]**

Breakfast on board.

**07:00** Heading off to the **Nichigo Resort & Country Club**, which actually features three courses. The fairways are wide and although water has been used sparingly, the challenge ahead is indeed interesting.

**13:30** Lunch on board while cruising along Kwai Noi River.

**15:00** River rafting or canoeing downstream on Kwai Noi River. If time allows, visit nearby the Mon Village.

**19:30** Dinner and overnight on board.

## SATURDAY

### DAY 3

#### SAI YOK-BAN KAO

Breakfast on board while cruising along Kwai Noi River.

07:00

**Mida Golf Club**, formerly known as The Lion Hills Golf and Country Club, is set among Kanchanaburi beautiful rugged mountains hills and relies on water for most of its hazards, providing an exciting test of golf.

From fairways to greens, this seventeen-year-old course is always in excellent condition and provides an exciting as well as enjoyable golf game for all class of players. Most of the holes are flat and straightforward, with slight undulation on each green that makes straight putting more important than good reading. Their signature hole, the 586 yards par-5 12th, with a water hazard on the right as well as OB on the left running from the tee-box to the green, is sure to be quite a challenge.

Return to RV River Kwai.

13:00

Lunch on board while cruising and viewing scenery at its best.

16:00

Thai Cooking Class: There is no better way to learn Thai cooking than taking an authentic cooking class in Thailand. However this basic cooking class – on deck of RV River Kwai - will introduce you to the wonderful world of Thai flavors. During classes the school's instructional emphasis is focused on three things: traditional Thai technique, innovative use of ingredients and aesthetic presentations. Spend a few hours learning to prepare a traditional Thai cocktail ('Mai Tai'), authentic Thai dishes (e.g. 'Tom Yam Kung' or 'Chicken Green Curry') and a Thai green papaya salad ('Som Tam'). An experience not to be missed!

"Farewell Dinner" and overnight on board.

## SUNDAY

### DAY 4

#### BAN KAO-KANCHANABURI-BANGKOK

[B/L/-]

06:00

Offering foods to monks (making merit in Buddhist style) at Chukkadon Market in Kanchanaburi.

Breakfast on the boat whilst cruising to Nong Ya.

09:30

Disembark and return to Kanchanaburi by coach.

Visit to Wat Tham Khaopoon, a Buddhist temple which served as a big camp of World War II. There is a middle cave containing stalactites and stalagmites and many remarkable Buddha images. Behind the temple enjoy a marvelous view down the valley of the Kwai Noi River.

Continue by bus to visit the Thailand-Burma Railway Center Museum, an interactive museum which provides a remarkable research and information center dedicated to presenting the story of the Thailand-Burma Railway. Then, visit to the well maintained Don Rak war cemetery which contains the remains of 6,982 Allied prisoners of war who perished during the construction of the infamous "Death Railway". Its tranquility still reminds visitors of the war and its aftermath.

Finally, visit to the world-famous bridge over the River Kwai. The sturdy Iron Bridge spanning the River Kwai Yai, which was a crucial part of the Death Railway, was built in some 16 months by Allied prisoners of war and Asian conscripts. The bridge was destroyed in Allied bombing raids towards the end of World War II and was later rebuilt by the Japanese as war reparations.

12:00

Lunch at the Rabiang FA Restaurant, near the confluence of the two rivers Kwai Yai and Kwai Noi.

13:15

Proceed to Bangkok.

18:00

Arrive Bangkok and transfer to your hotel in Bangkok downtown.

## CRUISE OPERATIONS 2021-2022

- RV River Kwai need a minimum of 4 (four) clients to guarantee operation of any cruises, except for Upstream departures (marked in yellow) can be operated without minimum number of passengers for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of every month (see cruise schedule).

### **Child Policy:**

- Children of 4 years and older must solely occupy a berth and pay the full rate (same as adults).
- Infants below the age of 4 years may sleep in their parent's cabin without extra charge but parents are to provide own baby food.
- NO triple rooms or extra beds are available.

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**Inclusive of:**

- Accommodation on RV River Kwai, meals as mentioned above, coffee, tea & drinking water.
- Transfers and sightseeing tours with English speaking local guide (together with other cruise members) (other language inquiry will be subject to such language availability).
- Entrance fees.

**Not included:**

- Optional tours.
- Expenditures of a personal nature for bar and laundry.
- Gratuity to crew.

**Reservation Policy:**

- Option terms can be offered as follows:  
More than 120 days prior the departure date : 30 days option

3. Whilst our crew do everything in their power to facilitate landings, access to the ship at certain river stations can be difficult, with steep and sometimes slippery riverbanks. Elderly clients should consult their doctor to ensure that they are fit for travel. Wheelchairs are not allowed.
4. In the case of water levels being too high or low or defects to the vessel beyond the control of Cruise Asia Ltd. an alternative itinerary will be offered to passengers after consultation between the ship's captain and the management of Cruise Asia Ltd., subject to accommodation and meals being maintained on board RV River Kwai.
5. Embarkation and disembarkation points are set according to the program. For individually requested embarkation or disembarkation points, Cruise Asia Ltd. takes over *no* additional costs for transport to and from the alternative embarkation or disembarkation point; unless passengers or their agencies have booked a complete package tour that includes additional land services through us. A reason for changing the embarkation or disembarkation points cannot be considered as a reason for terminating this contract.

14. It is not permitted to allow any kind of animal on board.
15. Infants under 4 years of age can stay in their parents' cabin at no extra charge. No cots or extra beds are available. The parents are responsible for their infants' meal. Children from 4 years of age must occupy a bed and pay full price without exception.
16. In the event of a dispute the law of the country in which the vessel is operating will apply > Thailand.

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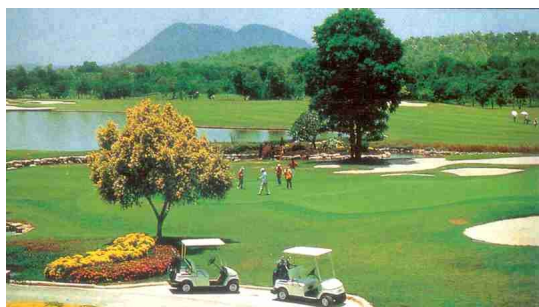
